



- Auggie Ramos gave road report to commissioners.
- Motion by Commissioner Holland and seconded by Commissioner Stewart to approve a permit for Lario Oil & Gas on CR D3401 being 12" in diameter, made of 24" casing and used for the transmission of water. Commissioner Blocker abstained. All voted yes. Copies on file in Clerk's office.
- Motion by Commissioner Holland and seconded by Commissioner Blocker to approve Driveway Permit for Waterfield Midstream LLC on CR D2051. All voted yes. Copies on file in Clerk's office.
- Motion by Commissioner Stewart and seconded by Commissioner Blocker to approve payment of \$13,224.17 for Landfill, \$250.93 for Chamber of Commerce, and \$43.95 for Stanton Volunteer Fire Department, which is ½ of charges. All voted yes. Copies on file in Clerk's Office.
- Improvements and Repairs: Judge Cox received an agreement from City of Stanton to give the County's portion of College Street to the City of Stanton. Judge Cox told court again about lawsuit involving a Sheriff's sale back in 2014-2015. (John Woodward was Sheriff) Judge Cox checking on property for new Food Bank.
- Motion by Commissioner Stewart and seconded by Commissioner Blocker to approve Bobby Holland for Presiding Officer Pro Tem for 2019. All voted yes.
- Motion by Commissioner Stewart and seconded by Commissioner Holland to Certify 2019 Budget and declaration of working under it since January 1, 2019. All voted yes.
- Motion by Commissioner Stewart and seconded by Commissioner Blocker to set Martin County Officials as being paid on a salary basis. All voted yes.
- Motion by Commissioner Stewart and seconded by Commissioner Blocker to leave the Salary Grievance Committee the same as before. All voted yes.
- Motion by Commissioner Stewart and seconded by Commissioner Blocker to leave the court terms for County and Justice of Peace Courts the same as before. All voted yes.
- Motion by Commissioner Holland and seconded by Commissioner Blocker to approve donation from Concho to Martin County Sheriff's Office for \$15,734.84. All voted yes.

- Motion by Commissioner Stewart and seconded by Commissioner Holland to approve donation from Mrs. Avery to the Martin County Library in the amount of \$10,000.00. All voted yes.
- Motion by Commissioner Stewart and seconded by Commissioner Blocker to adjourn at 09:43 am. All voted yes.
