

- Endeavor Energy Resources LLC has 2 permit both located on CR C3600 being 16" in diameter, made of Poly (encased) and used for the transmission of produced water. Third permit located on CR B2400 being 12" in diameter, made of poly (encased) and used for the transmission of produced water. Fourth permit located on CR A3701 being 12" in diameter, shall be made of Layflat, and used for the transmission of water. Fifth permit located on CR A3801 being 12" in diameter, made of Layflat, and used for the transmission of water. Sixth permit located on CR A3600 being 12" in diameter, made of Layflat, and used for the transmission of water. Seventh permit located on CR A3500 being 12" in diameter, made of Layflat, and used for the transmission of water.
