- Joel & J.T. gave road report to Commissioners.
- Motion by Commissioner Holland and seconded by Commissioner Stewart to approve all permits listed below. All voted yes. Copies on file in Clerk's office.
- Medallion Pipeline Company LLC: First located on CR A3600 diameter not listed on permit, made of steel (encased), and shall be used for the transmission of oil. Second located on CR A3500 being 8" in diameter, made of steel (encased), and shall be used for the transmission of oil. Third located on CR A4051 being 10" in diameter, made of steel (encased), and shall be used for the transmission of oil. Last located on CR A4000 being 10" in diameter, made of steel (encased) and shall be used for the transmission of oil.
- Diamondback Energy c/o Gesch Contracting Inc. located on CR A4501 being 16" in diameter, made of steel (encased), and shall be used for the transmission of 4-4" poly

produced water and 1-2" gas line. Second located on CR A4501 being 16" in diameter, made of steel (encased) and used for the transmission of 4-4" poly produced water and 1-2" poly gas line.

- Waterfield Midstream Operating II LLC has 5 permits. First: Located on CR C3100 being 16" in diameter, made of poly (encased) and shall be used for the transmission of water. Second: Located on CR C3301 being 16" in diameter, made of poly (encased), and shall be used for the transmission of water. Third: Located on CR C3201 being 12" in diameter, made of poly (encased), and shall be used for the transmission of water. Fourth: Located on CR D3600 being 20" in diameter, made of poly (encased) and shall be used for the transmission of water. Fifth: Located on CR C3600 being 16" in diameter, made of poly (encased) and shall be used for the transmission of water. Last located on CR D3400 being 20" in diameter, made of poly (encased) and shall be used for the transmission of water.
- Junction Resources LLC located on CR A4401 being 18" in diameter, made of poly (encased), and shall be used for the transmission of water.
- Blackline Energy Services LLC has 5 permits. First located on CR C3100 being 20" in diameter, made of poly and shall be used for the transmission of water. Second located on CR C3301 being 20" in diameter, made of poly and used for the transmission of water. Next four located on CR A3600, CR A3500, CR C3100, and CR C3301 all being 20" in diameter, made of poly and all used for the transmission of water.
- WTG Gas Processing LP has 2 permits. First located on CR A4300 being 6" in diameter, made of poly pipe and used for the transmission of natural gas. Second located on CR B3801 being 20" in diameter, made of poly and used for the transmission of natural gas.
- Delek Permian Gathering LLC has 4 permits. Located on CR D3401, CR D4100, CR D4300, and CR D4400 all being 8" in diameter, made of steel (encased) and used for the transmission of crude oil.
- Lario Oil & Gas Company has 2 permits. Located on CR B2500 and CR B2700 both 10" in diameter, made of 16" steel casing, and shall be used for the transmission of water.
- Parsley Energy c/o Gech Contracting Inc. has 2 permits. Located on CR B 2400 and CR B2300 both 12" in diameter, made of steel for 8" poly, and used for the transmission of water.
- Driveway Permit for EES Construction Division located on CR A4200.

- Driveway permit for Nitro Construction located on CR A4200.
- Driveway permit for Guidon Energy located on CR C2400.
- Improvements and Repairs: Discussion about a new Community Center and locations. Convent wants storage container to store wood not being used. Motion by Commissioner Holland and seconded by Commissioner Stewart to purchase a 40' container. Sheriff Ingram also said a storage container for their office needed to be moved.
- Motion by Commissioner Stewart and seconded by Commissioner Blocker to approve payment of \$17,052.02 for Landfill and \$437.77 for Chamber of Commerce which is ½ of charges. All voted yes. Copies on file in Clerk's Office.
- Motion by Commissioner Stewart and seconded by Commissioner Blocker to approve extending current fuel contract with Franklin & Son for Road & Bridge Dept. All voted yes.
- Motion by Commissioner Holland and seconded by Commissioner Blocker to approve a new 2-year contract with Prichard & Abbott with County Tax Collection software. All voted yes. Copy on file in Clerk's office.
- Motion by Commissioner Blocker and seconded by Commissioner Holland to approve advertising for 2 Road and Bridge Pickups. Amend dates for receiving & opening bids. Receive bids starting June 25, 2019. Bids will be opened July 23, 2019 during court. All voted yes.
- Motion by Commissioner Blocker and seconded by Commissioner Holland to approve LGS software contract for County Judge's office. \$535.00 one-time cost. \$282.00 per month. All voted yes. Copy on file in Clerk's office.
- Motion by Commissioner Stewart and seconded by Commissioner Holland to pay election workers for the contracted election on May 4, 2019 held for the City of Stanton. All voted yes.
- Representatives from Delek spoke to court about pipeline requirements. Commissioners kept requirements in place.
- Brandon Ireton did a presentation on a possible new Sports Complex for Martin County.
- Motion by Commissioner Stewart and seconded by Commissioner Blocker to adjourn at 11:05 am. All voted yes.
