

Martin County Elections Emergency Action Plan

Re: COVID-19

Effective June 29, 2020

In order to help minimize risk of exposure for the Election workers and Voters of Martin County, the Martin County Elections office has implemented the following EAP to go into effect Monday, June 29, 2020.

Democrat Primary Run-off

Early Voting: June 29 thru July 2rd (3rd Closed for 4th of July observance) then July 6 to 10, 2020. Open 8am to 5pm -Closed for lunch 12pm to 1pm.

Election Day: Tuesday July 14, 2020 7am to 7pm

Emergency Action Plan for July Elections

1. Voter will be asked to wear a mask while in the voting area.
2. Voter will be asked to use hand sanitizer before and after voting.
3. Hand sanitizer will be provided for both the voter and election worker.
4. Sanitized reusable Pencils will be provided for use on the voting machines.
5. There will be a limit of 10 or less people allowed in voting location at one time, this includes staff and election workers.
6. All voters and election staff are required to maintain 6 ft. distance between each person(s) at all times, unless within the same family unit.
7. Each election worker will be provided with gloves, mask and face shields that can be used during election period.
8. Curbside voting will be available for sick, disabled or elderly people.
9. Voting by Mail is available for qualified applicants.
